Return to School Guidelines 2020/21 Middle School Cohort 6-8

H E A L T H

- Students on campus will wear a mask during the day.
- Students will be given mask breaks when in the classroom when socially distant.
- Students will remain in their classrooms for the day, except for PE or recess which will be outside whenever possible or in the gym as weather permits.
 - Students will move for split math classes. We will move outside the building weather permitting.
- Students will not wear masks when in PE or recess when active and staying socially distant. Students will not be changing for PE.
- Students are asked to bring their own mask but we will provide SFdS masks for each student at school.
- Masks should be washed regularly.
- Middle School students will remain in their classrooms when we first return and teachers will rotate classrooms.
- Students will practice social distancing in the classroom with desks aligned and distanced as recommended.
- We have purchased new equipment to clean our classrooms.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the school, including at the entrance/exit of every classroom.
- Common areas will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Each Middle School grade will be assigned a bathroom that is separate from the other school grades. 6th will be by the Priest's office, 7th will be in the bathroom off their classroom, and 8th will be the bathroom between the 7th and 8th grade classrooms.
- Middle School students will have recess with their own class. They are asked to wear a mask if they are standing close and socializing, but if they are active and/or socially distant, they may remove their mask.
- There will be a limited amount of shared supplies, and supplies will be cleaned if needed to be shared between uses.
- We will train students on our expectations, i.e. on how to socially distance, wash hands, clean shared supplies, and processes and procedures throughout the school.

A C A D E	 Our 20-21 school year will begin on August 31st with students on campus 5 days. Class size has been limited to no more than 20 students per classroom. Specials will be going into the classroom or taking the children outside

Students in 6-8 grade will have their teachers rotate into their classroom daily. Each student will be given a chromebook that is used for academics. Chromebooks are expected to be fully charged at the start of the school day. Textbooks have been upgraded to easily have online components available to access from anywhere, on campus or at home. To better address any "gaps" in learning because of the virtual learning last year, we will be working on units that are cross-curricular and will emphasize several priority standards in different subject areas. Standards based grading and assessment will continue with an emphasis

N S	 Fall sports programs have been canceled by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee. At this time winter sports have not been discussed. Clubs have been postponed at this time.
	Mass will be celebrated to meet the social distancing guidelines. Mass
