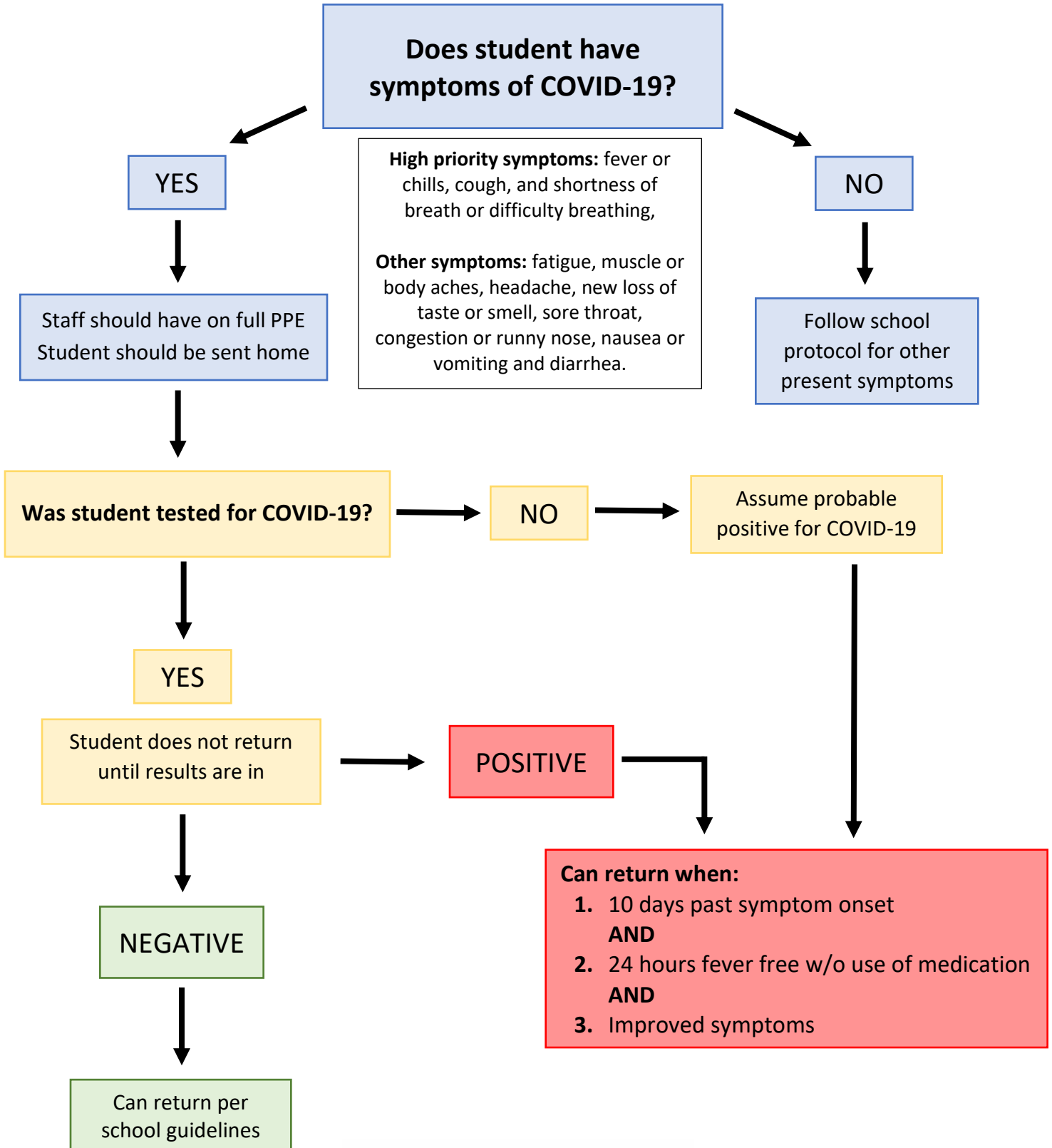


COVID-19 Decision Tool for School Nurses



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If the student was exposed to someone with COVID-19

They should be at home in quarantine (see scenarios below for return to school)

Scenario 1: The student is in quarantine for 14 days since the last day of exposure. They should monitor for signs and symptoms. If no symptoms develop, the student should finish the 14-day quarantine and then return to school.

- Ex: If a student was exposed on September 7th, they are to quarantine until September 21st → they are able to return to school September 22nd.

Scenario 2: The student is in quarantine and they go on to develop symptoms
