### Return Guidelines for 2020/21

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- Students on campus are required to wear a mask throughout the day.
- Students are asked to bring two of their own masks which should be labeled with their name and placed in a ziplock bag.
- We will also provide a SFdS mask for each student at school.
- Your child's ziplock bag containing their masks will be sent home each night. Please ensure that these are washed daily.
- Students will be given mask breaks during the day, when students are social distancing.
- Students will not wear masks when in PE or recess while they are being active.
- Students will remain in their classrooms for the day, except for PE or recess which will be outside whenever possible or in the gym as weather permits.
- Students will practice social distancing in the classroom with desks aligned and distanced as recommended.
- Best practices will be taught and emphasized in the classroom.
  - Regular hand washing breaks will occur often. Sinks are available in the classroom.
  - Students should bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer to be kept on their desk.
  - Students will not be able to drink from the water fountain. Each child **MUST** have a water bottle labeled with their name. They will be able to refill their bottles throughout the day.
  - Sharing of classroom supplies will be kept to a minimum. Each child's extra supplies will be placed in a ziplock bag and given back to that child as needed. Please ensure that all supplies are clearly labeled.
  - Students will practice social distancing and classroom furniture has been placed to help ensure the safety of all.
- We have purchased new equipment to clean our classrooms.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the school.
- Common areas will be cleaned throughout the day.
- Bathrooms--We will not be taking classroom breaks, instead we will be sending children in pairs to the restroom as needed.
- Outdoor scheduled recesses will be limited to 25 children. At this time we will keep the playground equipment closed until we can clean the equipment properly.

<p style="text-align: center;">A C A D E M I C S</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Our 20-21 school year will begin on August 31st with students on campus, all 5 days.</li> <li>● Class size has been limited to no more than 20 students a classroom.</li> <li>● Specials will be going into the classroom or taking the children outside or to the gym whenever possible.</li> <li>● Each special’s teacher will only see one cohort on any given day.</li> <li>● Students in PK-5th grade will remain with their teacher throughout the day, except for specials.</li> <li>● Textbooks have been upgraded to easily have online components available to access from anywhere, on campus or at home.</li> <li>● To better address any “gaps” in learning because of the virtual learning last year, we will be working on units that are cross-curricular and will emphasize several priority standards in different subject areas.</li> <li>● Standards-based grading and assessment will remain the same.</li> </ul>
<p style="text-align: center;">O T H E R  C O N C E R N S</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Students will eat lunch in the classrooms, hot lunch options will be available. Our goal is to move back to the gym for lunches whenever possible.</li> <li>● Bus service will be available, and information will come from our bus service provider. We do recognize and recommend you drive your student to school to limit exposure on the bus.</li> <li>● Drop off and Pick up process will be reviewed and practiced with the children. We will be using at least three different entrance and exit points to evenly distribute the students.</li> <li>● Visitors in the building will be limited. If you need to drop something off to your child, please bring it to our new office area and we will deliver to the classroom.</li> <li>● All fundraisers, field trips, and fall events through September have been canceled. We will review moving forward after October 1st.</li> <li>● Fall sports programs have been cancelled by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee.</li> <li>● Mass will be aligned to meet the social distancing guidelines and the school will be divided into two different attendance groups. Our Mass will be on Tuesday at 8:45.</li> </ul>

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- If a child shows symptoms in a classroom, the teacher will check the child's temperature and send him/her to our isolation area.
- When the temperature is 100.4 or higher, the parents will be notified to have the child picked up.
- Before school, we ask that you check your child for symptoms and their temperature daily. Please do not send your child to school if he or she is sick or showing any symptoms. See checklist attached.
- If a case of COVID is identified in your child's class, you will be notified and the Department of Health will set the guidelines for our next steps.
- Parents are asked to keep the school updated if your child or family members in your household are exposed to or test positive for COVID.
