



Return to School Guidelines 2020/21

Masks Regulations

SFdS will provide a school mask for all students.

- All adults in the school building are required to wear a mask. (Exceptions only granted with a written doctor's excuse).
- Adults may remove mask during their designated lunch break or when they are in a classroom or office alone.
- All students in the building are required to wear a mask in all common areas, hallways, bathrooms. (Exceptions only granted with a written doctor's excuse.)
- Teachers have discretion as to when mask breaks can be taken in the classroom. Social distancing practices will be in place during masks breaks.
- Masks are not required during lunch, recess, or P.E. class.
- Masks with ear loops may be worn on a lanyard provided by the school.
- Students will be required to bring to school at least two clean masks daily. Please label the masks or a plastic bag that contains the mask.
- Masks of any color or pattern can be worn, as long as they do not have any vulgar or political messaging. Neck gaiter masks are permitted. Principal has the final authority on the appropriateness of a mask.
- Masks will be provided to anyone who forgets or loses his/her mask. They will also be provided if a mask becomes compromised during the school day.
- Masks will be worn exiting the building
- Masks are expected to be cleaned daily at home.

K3 – K4 students in the building are allowed to wear a mask but NOT required.
