Can I send my child his own mask? Of course, you can send your child in your own mask. We will have at least two masks on campus for each student as needed.

When can we get more information? The teachers and staff are creating a more detailed outline of our day on campus and what a day of online learning will look like. I expect that parents will have the updated plan the week of August 17th.

Middle School Middle School students will remain in their classrooms and the teachers will change classes at the start of school year. We are looking at plans to disinfect the room during class changes. If we are able to do that, we will have students change classes later in the quarter. You will be notified.

Students need to be active; how will you keep them physically active?

Students will have the opportunity to play at recess with their class and have PE in the gym. Students will need to move around and will be able to move around the class while wearing their masks.

If we chose to be in the classroom at beginning, can we decide to switch to virtual if it feels more comfortable? Students can move to virtual if they have been exposed to COVID 19 or other medical reasons. We ask that you make a commitment to a learning platform for at least a quarter. You will need to meet with the Principal and Pastor if an exception needs to make.

Virtual learning option for second quarter? We will continue to offer virtual learning second quarter based on the circumstances at that time.

If students have to move to virtual learning because of COVID will students have a "live" classroom experience? Yes, online learning will have opportunities for live streaming instruction.

Will the masks the school provides comes with a filter? Where would I be able to purchase the filters? Yes, the masks the school provides comes with a filter. It is a PM2.5 filter. The filters are available for purchase on Amazon if you search for PM2.5 filter.

Concerned over the chain reaction that will occur if one student or teacher or family becomes sick then the number of kids sent home to quarantine, then back to school, then sick again. Would rather start the year with a consistent and well-designed online program. The necessity to quarantine a class is a true concern for us all.
