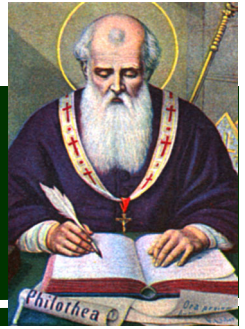

YOUTH SUNDAY MASSES

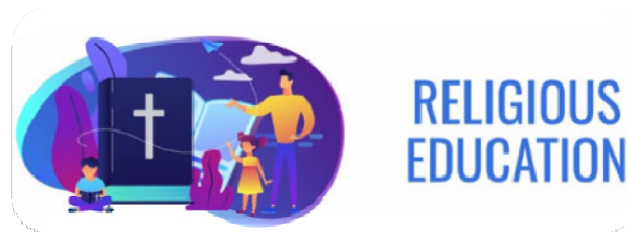

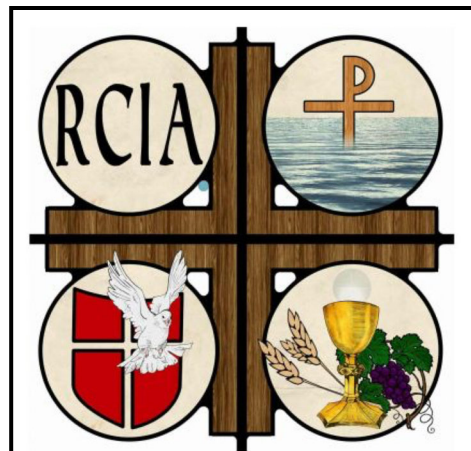
This week's Feast of St. Hippolytus is a great time to discuss an issue that still creates confusion among Greek Orthodox and Roman Catholics when dealing with the theology of the Holy Trinity (*notice the three rays around Jesus in Hippolytus's picture*). As many may realize the issue that we believe in the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit and call it monotheism a belief in one God to many seemed like insanity. Because you believe in Father, Son and Spirit as all God then you are either polytheist as the Greek and Roman world said or illogical. Which for that

world during the time of St. Hippolytus would not have been a problem even among many Christians.

There were various beliefs among Catholic groups in the second and third century about the Trinity. Such as those who believed in the subordination of Jesus to the Father, for after all didn't Jesus pray to the Father to remove the cup of suffering from him. There were other groups that believed that Jesus did not become God until raised from the dead after the Crucifixion. There are verses in the Gospel of John that would seem to support that belief if read literally. That is why we as Catholics and Orthodox have never read the Bible literally with such theological intricacies.

One very powerful belief at the time which even the Pope at the time of St. Hippolytus followed was a form of Trinitarian belief known as modalism. What Modalism professed is that Father, Son, and Spirit are one God put in three different modes of the same God, hence modalism. To explain this view about three different modes, we can say a married man can be a Father, Brother and Son all at the same time. He has a Father, so he is a Son. In his family there are others born of his parents so he is brother, and he and his wife have had children so he is a Father. Hence he is in the mode of Father, Brother, and Son depending on who he is relating to and yet all the one Person.

We as Catholics and Orthodox rejected Modalism (modes), as well Adoptionism (At the Resurrection), as well Subjugation, which is why we say equal in majesty and glory. Instead through great Saints like Hippolytus we teach, One Substance, Three Personas, Undivided in Power and Majesty and United as One God: Father, Son and Spirit. Hippolytus with other great Fathers of the Church Professed this form of Trinitarianism that is Platonically based on The Logos as the singular infinite substance from which all other realities get their meaning. For that reason, we now use the original word in our Creed on Sundays, Consubstantial with the Father: as is the Spirit.

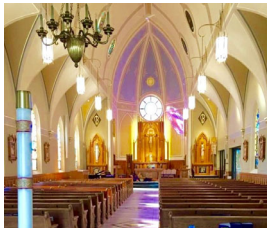
